## CITY OF GOOSE CREEK RECREATION DEPARTMENT POOL RULES

- 1. All members must have their membership card with them and sign in before entering the pool area. Members without their card will be required to pay the \$3 daily fee NO EXCEPTIONS. There is a \$5 fee to replace lost or stolen membership cards.
- 2. All patrons must have a membership or purchase a \$3 daily fee to enter the pool area.
- 3. Children under age 12 must be accompanied by an adult (adult being 16 years or older).
- 4. No one is permitted in the water unless a lifeguard is present.
- 5. Any child unable to swim without assistance must always be accompanied by an adult in the pool.
- 6. No running or "horse play" in the pool and deck area.
- 7. No rough play, shoulder rides or dunking.
- 8. No profanity or any other unpleasant conduct affecting the comfort of others will not be tolerated.
- 9. The use of air horns, whistles or any other emergency signaling devices is strictly forbidden.
- 10. No diving (shallow water).
- 11. Persons with skin, eye, ear or respiratory infections, open sores or lesions and band-aids should not enter the pool.
- 12. Proper swim attire is required. Cutoffs, jean shorts and street clothes are not permitted.
- 13. Children with diapers must wear a proper swim diaper under their bathing suit.
- 14. No pets in the pool or deck area.
- 15. No food or beverages near or in the pool. No glass containers permitted in the facility.
- 16. Food may NOT be delivered to the facility (example pizza delivery).
- 17. NO ALCOHOL will be permitted in the pool facility.
- 18. No person under the influence of alcohol or drugs will be admitted into the facility.
- 19. No spitting or blowing nose in the pool.
- 20. NO radios will be allowed; personal listening devices such as I-pods are permitted.
- 21. The maximum number of swimmers allowed in the pool is 200.
- 22. Supervisors reserve the right to deny access to any member if the facility has reached the maximum capacity allowed by law.
- 23. A first aid kit is located in the lifeguard office.
- 24. Persons with diarrhea illness or nausea are not permitted in the pool. Doing so will risk the health and safety of all others in the pool.
- 25. Lifeguards judgment prevails.
- 26. No soliciting will be allowed on the pool premises.
- 27. Supervisors have the discretion to close the pool at any time, for any reason.
- 28. In the event of inclement weather such as thunder, lightning, heavy wind and rain the facility will be closed, and remain closed until all threats to public health have dissipated. All patrons must EXIT the facility. Supervisors reserve the right to close the facility early.
- 29. The City of Goose Creek will not be responsible for any valuables brought into the facility.
- 30. Willful destruction of property will result in the suspension or revocation of membership.
- 31. Anything not specifically covered in the rules that affect the health, safety and comfort of pool patrons will be left to the discretion of the pool staff.
- 32. Please respect your fellow members and staff of the pool facility.
- 33. Any person or persons violating any of the above rules and regulations may have their membership suspended or revoked at any time.
