REGISTRATION DATES: January 6-29, 2025

Birth Certificate and proof of residency are required when registering. Acceptable forms of proof of residency = **Homeowners**: Drivers license or picture ID and most recent utility bill. **Renters**: Drivers license or picture ID, most recent utility bill and original rental agreement. Current address must be on all proofs of residency. There is an additional **\$15.00 late fee** for players registering after January 29, *if space is available*. Otherwise, players registering after the deadline will be placed on a waiting list.

LEAGUE FEES:

<u>Residents</u>: \$50 per child. (Includes GC Recreation District Residents and City of Goose Creek residents) **Non-Residents**: \$85 per child

Participants will receive a team jersey, pants, hat/visor, and socks.
Participants must provide their own glove, batting helmet, bat and cleats.
T-Ball League does NOT require a batting helmet. Bats not to exceed 29".
Coach Pitch & Modified Kid Pitch League– Face masks are mandatory on helmets. Chinstrap is required if the helmet has a hole or snaps.
Face masks OR face guard are mandatory for ages 9-10 and are optional, but strongly recommended for ages 11 & up.
Helmets can't be modified in any way—NO stickers, decals or paint allowed.
ALL HELMETS AND FACE MASKS MUST BE NOCSAE APPROVED.
Metal cleats are allowed in the 13 & up Baseball and Softball leagues ONLY.
Dixie Baseball Bats (9 & up)- All 2 5/8" bats and 2 1/4" bats must have the USA baseball stamp and cannot exceed 33" in length.

Dixie Boys (13-14) ONLY- BBCOR bats are allowed

Softball 2 1/4" bats stamped official softball, youth softball and/or fastpitch softball and cannot exceed 34" in length.
